That the said *Leetitia Carson* _____ entered upon and made settlement on said land on the *17th* day of *June* _____, 1863, and has built a house thereon *of heavy logs about 18 + 22 feet 1 1/2 stories high two doors and two windows a comfortable house to live in* and has lived in the said house and made it his exclusive home from the *17th* day of *June* _____, 1863, to the present time, and that he has since said settlement ploughed, fenced, and cultivated about _____ acres of said land, and has made the following improvements thereon, to wit: *built a barn granary smoke house and has planted about 100 fruit trees*
