

## BIG SQUAW MOUNTAIN

Umpqua National Forest 28S-1W-13



**July 20, 1932:** "Nine new lookout houses are to be built at an estimated cost of \$5,300. [*One of*] these will be built on Big Squaw mountain on the Little river-South Umpqua divide. Pasture fences are to be built at Big Squaw mountain." **(Roseburg News-Review)** 

1933: An L-4 cab built on a 10-foot timber tower.

1933: A pasture fence of logs and poles constructed at a cost of \$36.75. (Umpqua National Forest files)



August 12, 1933: Panorama photos taken by William Birchall & Lester Moe.

August 21, 1934: "Several acres of clearing to Increase visibility for the lookout of Big Squaw mountain has been completed." (CCC) (Roseburg News-Review)

1935: An additional \$6.02 spent on the pasture fencing. (Umpqua National Forest files)

**1941:** The lookout was staffed for 80 days and reported to the Steamboat Bridge Ranger Station. Communications were by way of forest line to Pacific Telephone and Telegraph.
