From 1991 to 2001, Mr. Thorne was executive director of the Port of Portland, a regional port authority responsible for ownership and management of marine terminals, airports and business parks located in Portland, Oregon. From 2002 to 2004, he was director and chief executive officer of the Washington State Ferry System in Seattle, Washington.
