KNOWN ARCHEOLOGICAL FEATURES:

SETTING: The Nugget Schoolhouse was built approximately nine miles east of the city of Myrtle Creek on the South Myrtle Creek near the community of Nugget. Shallow hills rise to the north and steeply to the south creating a narrow valley at the site. Land surrounding the schoolhouse is for grazing. A mature maple tree shades the schoolhouse from the south and mature cedars shelter it on the north.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (USE ADDITIONAL SHEETS IF NECESSARY): The present schoolhouse is the second structure used in the Nugget, a farming and mining community. School District #57 was created in 1902. The first lessons were taught at the new schoolhouse in c. 1910 and continued until consolidation with the Myrtle Creek School District in 1943. Mrs. Margaret Dyer, Mrs. Edna Potter and Mrs. Nora Stevens were some of the teachers at the Nugget Schoolhouse.
